

Regulations for the Establishment of Bilingual University Promotion Committee at I-Shou University

Adopted by the University Administration Council on
September 15, 2021, and promulgated with the consent from
the President dated on September 27, 2021

Amendments to Article 3 adopted by the University
Administration Council on March 23, 2022, and promulgated
with the consent from the President dated on April 9, 2022

- Article 1 The Bilingual University Promotion Committee (hereinafter referred to as “the Committee”) is established by I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as “the University”) with the aim of facilitating and practicing bilingual education, improving students’ English skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing and faculty members’ EMI skills, and broadening students and faculty members’ international perspectives.
- Article 2 The Committee is responsible for:
1. deliberating and facilitating bilingual education programs;
 2. reviewing the budget for bilingual education programs;
 3. implementing and monitoring bilingual education programs and compiling performance reports; and
 4. handling other affairs in relation to bilingual education programs.
- Article 3 The Committee shall have the following members: the President, vice presidents, the Dean of Academic Affairs, the Dean of Student Affairs, the Dean of International and Cross-strait Affairs, the Dean of Institutional Research, college deans, the Director of General Education, the Director of the Bilingual Education and EMI Center, and the Director of the Foreign Language Center. The chairperson and the executive secretary shall be the President and the Director of the Bilingual Education and EMI Center, respectively.
- Article 4 Committee members shall meet at least once every semester, and an extraordinary session may be called whenever necessary. The Committee may invite persons it thinks necessary to attend a committee meeting as participants without the power to vote.
- Article 5 The Bilingual Education and EMI Center is responsible for the administrative affairs of the Committee.

Article 6 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the University Administration Council and ratified by the President.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of the Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
